Erasmus+ project ***Making Business Education Business proof for the 21 Century*** had its third Transnational Meeting 25 – 26 March 2019. The meeting took place in Berufsbildende Schulen Rotenburg – Europaschule, in Rotenburg, Germany.



The project will produce 15 on-line modules for business VET. These will be ready by spring 2021. The modules will contain some of the most important **21 Century Skills** needed by business students and future oriented companies.

Project partners are ***ROC de Leijgraaf*** from the Netherlands (coordinator), ***BBS Rotenburg*** from Germany, ***Peterborough Regional College*** from the UK, and ***Secondary School for Administration of the European Union*** from Czech Republic, and ***Careeria***.
